

10.5 Project

- Further develop the themes and stories for the bush to beach path that enhance the Paths that Connect the Community Conceptual Framework.
- The art opportunities on this path are the six or more pedestrian - vehicle shared zones paving treatments. The design team, working with the local community, an identified artist will incorporate repeatable art elements into the contract documents: path treatments, benches, lighting and other street elements.
- 'Postcard' art opportunities at all path-street crossings. Engaging artists and community as form of placemaking initiative.

10.6 Ephemeral Events.

The vision of paths connecting the spaces and the community needs to happen, literally, one step at a time.

- The concept of less cars and more legs can be explored through a series of community events 'creating public space' which require road closures.
- The initial community event could start from behind the civic centre. 'This could be a shared zone' is the first step that will cause little disruption.
- This area is on the path.
- The theme for this first event could be an early evening community BBQ with projection of surf-skate movies and historical images onto the side of the Civic Centre. The historical images could come from the immediate residents.
- The purpose is to be outdoors and to make it very open to chance encounter. The publicity focus is to encourage walking-riding as a way to arrive.
- The success of this event will determine whether it needs to 'grow'. The solution to that will be to take it to the DLW for a few hours a week to align with the night markets. The intention is for it to remain a community event, aligning with the night markets, not an extension of the market stalls space.
- The 'original' event may stay at the civic centre on different nights as a projection opportunity that could lead to a Coolum Film Club.
- The intention for this shift is to calm the DLW for a few hours to empower the community to the potential of this space, to connect both sides of this edge and be more pedestrian friendly.
- The success of this event could lead to the road closure becoming an integral part of the night markets, which could operate more regularly.
